## CJEC Scholarship Requirements

### Requirements for a \$1000 Scholarship to be awarded by CJEC.

Scholarship applicants must:

- ◆ Be a citizen of the United States.
- ◆ Be from an area represented by one of the member societies of the Canton Joint Engineering Council.
- ◆ Have completed his or her college sophomore year
- ◆ Be accepted into the College of Engineering of a four- (4) year ABET accredited University of College.
- ◆ Have a minimum GPA of 2.75.

To apply, the applicant must submit, to the Chairman-Honors & Awards Committee, on or before January 31 of the year of the award.

- ◆ CJEC Scholarship Application form.
- ◆ Letter of interest addressing the evaluation factors of:
  - Collegiate achievement
  - Technical Society / Extra curricular activities
  - Financial need
- ◆ Copy of his or her transcripts
- ◆ Letter of Sponsorship from the appropriate member society.

A five-person committee consisting of the CJEC President, Treasurer, Executive Secretary, and two other delegates, will select the scholarship recipient based on the supplied information. The award will be presented at the Engineers' Week Banquet in February.
